The Clinton County Health Department will be administering **FREE** H1N1 vaccine according to the recommendations of The Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and Prevention. Priority groups that will be served at this time are as follows:

- All children and young adults aged 6 months through 24 years.
- Pregnant women
- People who live with or care for children younger than 6 months of age
- Healthcare and emergency medical services workers
- People ages 25 through 64 years who have chronic health conditions
