LAST DAY TO REGISTER TO VOTE

October 9, 2018

Last day to register as a new voter or transfer registration in the County Clerk's Office. Online registration is available at ova.elections.il.gov until October 21, 2018. The voter's address must be current on his/her driver's license to utilize the online registration system.

GRACE PERIOD VOTING

October 10, 2018 – November 6, 2018

Monday – Friday

8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.

Voters who have not registered to vote or missed updating voter registration by the cutoff date will be required to register and vote the same day in the County Clerk's Office.

ELECTION DAY REGISTRATION AND VOTING

November 6, 2018

8:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m.

Election Day Registration and Voting in the County Clerk's office is only for voters who have not registered to vote or missed updating voter registration by the close of registration. If you are unsure if you are registered please call the County Clerk's office or check on our website.

VOTE BY MAIL

Vote by Mail ballots are available to all registered voters for any reason.

August 8, 2018 – First day to request a vote by mail application.

November 1, 2018 – Last day for the County Clerk's office to receive an application for a vote by mail ballot via mail.
