Expenses were reviewed and approved by the committee members by signature.



Discussions were held between department heads regarding the maintenance of this layer. The GIS Coordinator will work with the county ETSB to develop this project, and work on acquiring the address point layer.

The GIS Coordinator informed the Committee that the annual Census BAS program would be handled by Jay. This updates the Census Bureau on annexations and other major boundary changes in the county. Also, the 10 year census is approaching and Jay will be the contact person for this.

Jay will meet with members of the County Board at the County Farm to review drainage. Time and date TBD.

The GIS Coordinator worked on subdivisions, enterprise zone, addresses, mapping variances, and mapping building permits this past month.
