Minutes
January 15, 2019 - 7:15 a.m.

1. Attendance:

2. Mr. Wessel made a motion to approve the minutes from the December 11, 2018 Highway Committee Meeting. Mr. Rakers seconded the motion. The motion passed.
3. The committee discussed the maintenance foreman's hours. Mr. Behrens told the committee that the maintenance foreman has been starting and finishing 30 minutes before other maintenance employees. This is being done in order to have the other employees begin working as soon as possible in the morning where they are not waiting to have the foremen schedule. Mr. Behrens told the committee that the foremen had been coming in 30 minutes early which was paid as overtime but in an attempt to reduce overtime, the present working hours are being tried.
4. Mr. Behrens told the Committee that they plan to set traffic counters out on some of the township roads being used as detour routes in conjunction with the states closure of the Crooked Creek Bridge on IL 161.
5. Mr. Behrens gave the Committee the results of the rock letting held January 10th. Mr. Wessel made a motion to include on the County Board Meeting a resolution awarding the rock bids to the various low bidders. Mr. Rakers seconded the motion. The motion passed.
6. Mr. Behrens gave the Committee a copy of a resolution that would allow board members who work the required numbers of hours to participate in IMRF. Mr. Rakers made a motion to include this resolution on the County Board agenda. Mr. Wessel seconded the motion. The motion passed.
7. Mr. Behrens told the Committee that they received information from IMRF that they have accepted all of the accelerated payment wavers to date.
8. Mr. Behrens told the Committee he would like to replace two trucks this year. The County's 2008 F250 and the County's 2009 F350. Mr. Sullivan made a motion to have this item placed on the Board meeting agenda. Mr. Wessel seconded the motion. The motion passed.
9. Mr. Behrens told the Committee that Kaskaskia College has requested the County install a flashing LED stop sign on College Road at Shattuc Road. The Committee did not wish to have the County purchase this sign to the expense of approximately \$1,500 and it would most likely lead to Villages requesting the same.
10. Mr. Behrens told the Committee that the college also requested a marked crosswalk across Shattuc Road to access the apartments to the west of the College.

11. Mr. Behrens gave the Committee a waterline permit application from Hoffman Rural water Co. to bore a new waterline under Shattuc Road. Mr. Wessel made a motion to include this on the County Board Meeting agenda. Mr. Rakers seconded the motion. The motion passed.

12. The Committee approved the current bills.
