

CLINTON COUNTY GIS COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

A regular meeting of the Clinton County GIS Committee was called to order on Tuesday, July 9, 2019 at 5:15 PM.

Expenses were submitted and approved by the committee.


A discussion was held on acquiring new aerial imaging. The Supervisor of Assessments emailed the GIS Coordinator that the Assessment Committee would like to see imagery acquired in the Spring of 2021. A discussion on aerial imagery followed. An early dollar amount from Sidwell for new imagery was between \$46,500 and \$51,000. This would be similar to the imagery Sidwell delivered in 2016 and would include Sidwell providing ground control points.

A discussion was held on measuring the activity of our online mapping GIS website. Jay handed out a sheet of paper regarding two years of website analytics. The committee reviewed the data.

The GIS Coordinator discussed upgrading the 911 GIS database to the state compliant NG911 format. A lot of coordination will be required for working with adjacent counties. All the data will need to be converted and the units will need to be changed from feet to degrees lat/long. He worked with John Skain on developing a RFP.

The GIS Coordinator worked on subdivisions, addresses, mapping variances, and mapping building permits this past month. He also mentioned that there has been a downturn in enterprise zone applications.
