Minutes
September 5, 2019 – 7:30 a.m.

1. Attendance:

2. Mr. Rakers made a motion to approve the minutes from the August 8, 2019 Highway Committee Meeting. Mr. Wessel seconded the motion. The motion passed.
3. The Committee opened bids for a new mowing tractor. Jansen Farm equipment was the apparent low bidder with a bid of \$34,300 for a Massey Ferguson 6713. Midwest Tractor had the second low bid of \$53,261 for a New Holland T5-120 and Riechmann Brothers turned in the 3rd low bid of \$58,500 for a John Deere 5125R. Mr. Behrens said that he will need to review the bids and verify that the tractors meet specifications. Mr. Wessel made a motion to have Mr. Behrens place the lowest bidder that meets the specs on the Board agenda. Mr. Rakers seconded the motion. The motion passed.
4. Mr. Behrens gave the Committee the results of the single axle dump truck bid that was held on August 29th. The low bid was for \$104,877 for a Kenworth submitted by CIT Trucks from Troy. Mr. Behrens told the Committee that the Kenworth meets the County's bid specs. Mr. Rakers made a motion to have the award of the low bid placed on the Board agenda. Mr. Wessel seconded the motion. The motion passed.
5. Mr. Behrens told the Committee that he is waiting for information from IDOT before proceeding with actions to vacate a portion of the right of way on Jamestown Road so that a memorial and be constructed by the Breese Historical Society..
6. Mr. Behrens told the Committee that the Moehle Trial concerning right of way along Shattuc Road is scheduled for October 3rd..
7. Mr. Behrens told the Committee they plan to open sealed bids on September 19 for the sale of the county's old patch wagon.
8. Mr. Behrens updated the Committee on the Boulder Road resurfacing project.
9. Mr. Behrens told the Committee that they plan to oil roads on the week of September 9th.
10. The Committee approved the current bills.
